

Beagh Bridge (contd.)

This is a stone Bridge consisting of 6 arches; it is erected over the river Beagh on the old line of road connecting Cahersiveen and Killorglan.

Faha Lodge (Sheet 63) -- Local 24

See T.L. -- J.O'D.

Situated in the East of the townland of Faha, parish of Glanbeagh and barony of Iveragh. This is the residence of the Revd. Mr. Ashe; it is a rectangular building, one story high & thatched.

Beaun Hill -- Lady Headly's Map.

Beann, a hilloe. Nothing would represent this sound but the Irish spelling beann.

Inchareagh Lodge (63) -- Local 25

Inse riach, grey helm.

Inchareagh Lodge -- J.O'D.; (See Orthog. Letter)

Situated in the East of townland Rossbeagh in the parish of Glanbeagh, barony of Iveragh.

This is the residence of Andrew Talbot; it was erected in 1824 by the late Lord Headley; it is a rectangular building, two stories high & in good repair. There is a good set of offices attached.

Rossbeagh Lodge (63) -- Local 26

See T.L. -- J.O'D.

Situated on the shore in the South of townland Rossbeagh. This Lodge was erected about 80 years ago by Robert Hassett; repaired about 20 years ago by the late Lord Headley; it is two stories high & in good repair. The property of Lady Headley, Aghadoe House, Killarney.
