

Rossbeagh Point (contd.)

- Rosbeh Point -- Barony Map
 Rosbet Point -- Larkin's Co. Map 1814

Situated in the Northern extremity of townland Rossbeagh in the Parish of Glanbeagh, barony of Iveragh and County of Kerry. A long narrow of land stretching northward into Dingle Bay.

- Reenallagaun Point -- Local 41

Rinn Eallagáin, Hallagan's point.

- Reenallagaun (See page 23) -- J.O'D.

Situated in the Northern extremity of townland Reenallagaun in the Parish of Glanbeagh. This is a long and narrow neck of land stretching Northward between Rossbeagh Creek & Caragh Creek.

- Wales's Inn (63) -- Local 42

- Wales' Inn -- Sketch Map

Situated in the South East of townland Keelnabrack Lower, Parish of Glanbeagh on the line of road connecting Cahersiveen and Killorglan. This is a Public House, kept by a man whose name is Wales; in it travellers meet with very good accommodation.

- Laghtshee (63) -- John O'Shea, Faha 43

Leaict Síde, fairy monument.

- Laghtshee -- J.O'D.

Situated on the summit of Curra Mountain between townlands Faha and Curra. A large heap of stones.

- Windy Gap (63) -- Local 44

Beárna na gaoite, gap of the wind.

- Windy gap -- J.O'D.

Situated in the South of townland Goulaun. This is a narrow pass through the Mountain.

- Giant's Seat (63) -- Local; J.O'D.

Situated at the meeting of Goulaun, Lauher and Threengorri. This is considered to have been formerly the seat of Giant; it is a small hillock.
