In the South of the County of Kerry and bounded on the N. by the parishes of Knocksun and Killsrney; on the East by the Parishes of Killska and Kilgarvan; on the South by Kilcaskin and on the West by the Parishes of Twosist and Templenos. All of which are in the same County.

This Parish (which is the property of the Marquis of Lansdowneand Trigity College, consists principally of mountain, pasture with a considerable portion of arable interspersed therethrough having the town of Lemmare erected in its Western extremity, and the Lanmare and Roghty Rivers running throuth it. The road leading from Bantry to Romare and also the road leading from Killarney to the latter townland together with several bye roads run through it.
