In the South of the County of Kerry and bounded on the N. by the parishes of Knockaun and Killarney; on the East by the Parishes of Killaha and Kilgarvan; on the South by Kilkaskin and on the West by the Parishes of Twosist and Templenos. All of which are in the same County.

This Parish (which is the property of the Marquis of Lansdowne and Trinity College, consists principally of mountain, pasture with a considerable portion of arable interspersed therethrough having the town of Kenmare erected in its Western extremity, and the Kenmare and Boghty Rivers running through it. The road leading from Bantry to Kenmare and also the road leading from Killarney to the latter townland together with several bye roads run through it.
