on the roof. Encompassing this house is a circular old graveyard 3 chains in diameter, the one half cultivated, and the other taken up with old graves and headstones with crosses on some of them.

Galleries Castle (42) -- Inhabitants 38

recte Gallrofs

Gallarus Castle -- J.O.D.

See T. L.

Gallarus -- Smith's Hist of Kerry 1756

Situated in the centre of Galleries townland.

This castle which is square is 27 feet each side and about 50 feet high, arched overhead by a stone roof. It is said to have been built by the Fitzgeralds.

Carrig Chapel -- Inhabitants 38

Carrig Chapel -- J.O.D.

Situated in the S.W. corner of Carrig townland.

This chapel was built between 1740 and 1760 by the parishioners. It is a cross house and straw thatched; is capable of containing about 500 persons. There has been a school always taught in it, the number of scholars varying from 200 to 30 male and female, by whom the master is paid from £8 to £15 per annum.

Lios Mór (42) -- Inhabitants 39

Big Fort

Lios mór , big fort.

Lismore -- J.O.D.

Situated in the centre of the townland of Murreagh.

This fort is circular, is 1½ chains in diameter and 4 feet high with a green flat surface composed of earth and from it can be seen Lios Ruadh and another in Caherorgan, South.

Lios Ruadh -- Inhabitants 39

Red fort.

Lios ruadh , red fort.

Lisroe

Situated in the N.W. part of Murreigh townland.

This fort which is also circular is 1½ chains in diameter, 4 feet high composed of earth with a green surface and from it can be seen the above forts.
