The property of John O'Connell Esqr Granna Killainey. Agent John Sullivan Tubrid Ardfert, let to 7 tenants at will at the yearly rent of £80. County Cess per acre yearly from 1s 2d to 2s 4d, tithe per acre from 4d. size of farms from 10 to 20 acres. Soil deep producing Wheat, Oats, and Potatoes and Barley, fuel scarce, prevailing names Corndon and Edward, there is one school containing 60 boys and 40 girls, all Roman Catholic, teacher paid by pupils quarterly, rates spelling 1s, reading and writing 1s 6d, arithmetic 2s 6d. There are three forts here.
