This is a low rock which cannot be seen in high water.

Rough Island (66) -- B. S. 13

Situated in the South side of Lough lane or lower lake of Killarney and West of Hen and Chickens and South of Ross island to which it belongs.

This island is wooded with Oak, Birch, Alder, yew, and Arbutus.

O'Donohoes Horse -- Inhabitants 13

Situated in the South side of Lough lane or Lower lake of Killarney and a little S.W. of Ash island.

This is a bare rock of a whitish colour. It is called by the inhabitants O'Donohoes Horse from the close resemblance it bears to that of a horse in the act of grazing. Strawberry Island

Situated in the South central end of Lough Guitaan very near Cow island and on the North side of it.

This is a small island whose surface is of a coarse mountainy nature.
