

## Ardagh Lake (contd)

Situated in the South central extremity of the townland of Ardagh.

Nothing remarkable in this lake but a grun and round sally bush which grows in the centre nearly.

Situated in the S.E. boundary between the townlands of Farta and Coals, and a little N.E. of the 3 townland points, viz, Farta Coals and Coars.

This lake is rather of an elliptic form its length about 16 chains and breadth 10, on the S. side there is a precipice whose angle of elevation is about 40 and distance 12 chains. There is a pure spring coming out of a rock on the S.W. side at the distance of 12 links from the edge or bulk, several fruitless experiments have been made in order to fathom the immense depth of this lake.

Eskallogha -- B. S. 15

Eisc a loca , Esk of the lake.

Esk is the track of a stream.

Eskalougha -- J.O.D.

Situated in the S.E. boundary between the townland of Gurtroca and that of Poulagour.

On the S. side of this lake there is a smooth precipice of about 80 links and at the foot of which there are a few trees of Holly, Black, Sally, and Roundtree.

Keabbracka Lake (84) -- B. S. 16
