 Cnoc an imrise , hill of the contention.
- Enockanimrish** -- J.O.D.  
 Situated in the S.E. end of the townland of Coars and N.E. of Kemabracka Lake.  
 Nothing remarkable in this lake.
- Loughagarrigarry (75)** -- B. S. 17  
 Loč garb-garraid , lake of the rough garden.
- Lough Garagarry** -- J.O.D.

 Situated in the S.E. boundary between the townland of Gurtárummakeery.  
 The Horses Glen ends in this lake nothing else remarkable.

 Situated in the boundary of the townland of Gurtárummakeery on the N.E. side and bounded on the North and East by the parish of Killaha.  
 There are 4 islands in this lake, viz, Horse island and Strawberry island in the central end, and bare island nearly in the centre of the lake.
