Meeting of the Waters , is the meeting of the three lakes, vis. Upper Lake Turk or middle lake and Lough Lane or Lower lake of Killarney.

Situated in the N.E. extremity of the Ross Island.

This Castle is in ruins, its base is 46 feet by 33 and height about 30 feet. The barrack is attached to the West side which is 100 feet in length , both castle and barrack are richly covered with green grass ivy, the upper floor in the top of the castle is covered with green grass, in the centre of which grows a handsome yew tree This castle formerly belonged to the O'Donohoe's but it was taken by General Ludlow in 1641. There are three large pieces of cannon planted on the S. side of this castle to be seen yet.
