Bounded on the North by Rathmore, and Ballyraymeen Lowerland on the West by Ballygambeen Lower and cuss, on the South by Rasheen and Mount Henry and on the East by Ballybrack.

Is the property of Lord Kenmare Killarney, population 44, County Cess 25 16s 7d contains A.216; R.L: P.2; of arable land with a little pasture towards the West, road from Killarney to Milltown forms its Southern boundary, and it is divided from the parish of Kiltella by the high water mark of Main river. There are two quarries in the Northern part.

Castle of Clounmeelaan -- Popular 20
