

- Cressanne or Cressane -- Local 29
 Cressán , a small glutton : that which swallows greedily.
- Cressane -- J.O.D.
 In the above townland in the S.W. side.
 A small lough within a short distance of the boundary.
- Lissparknastallogh -- Local 30
 Lios páirc na staille , fort of the field of the stallion.
- Lisparknastallia --J.O.D.
 Situated in the North Western part of Rathmore townland.
 A Fort
- Lissardawanig -- Local 30
 See T. I.
 Ardwanig fort -- J.O.D.
 In the townland of Ardawanig in the Western part.
 A Fort, there are three or four houses near this fort.
- Lissgartromarlogh (48) -- Local 31
 Lios a'capail , fort of the horse.
- Liscapull -- J.O.D.
 In the Southern part of Knocknamuckala townland.
 A Fort.
- Butterfield House (48) -- Local 32
 J.O.D.
- Batterfield -- Lord Kenmare See Letter
 Situated in the Eastern part of Gartromarlogh townland.
 Dwelling house in the orchard etc, 9 chains East of road, from Tralee to Killarney.
- Pirees Cross -- Local 32
 Near the middle of Pirees townland.
 Cross roads, one leading North and South from Tralee to Killarney, the other branching off to the West and leading to Milltown.
