Central of the Ph. Bounded on the N. by Knocklara, on the W. by Clohast, on the E. by Ballangarry and on the S. by Ballantubber in the Ph. of Barra. 49.

Is the property of W.H. Ryves Esq. Ballywire, contains 230 a. 3 r. 27 p. Statute measure. Nearly half of the Townland on the S. is mountain and the rest arable. It is separated from Knocklara (on N) by centre of road from Ballangarry (on E) by a stream. There is a very large Fort close to the Western By. which is called Liss-doonglan and another (Smaller) which lies East of it.
