CLONDALKIN

Clondalkin, an inland parish and village, partly in Newcastle, but chiefly in Uppercross barony, Dublin county, 41 miles S.W. from Dublin, comprising an area of 4,777 acres, of which 44 are in the village. Population, 2,179; of village, 271. It is situated near the ninth lock of the Grand Canal, and close to the line of the Great Southern Railway, of which it is the first station from Dublin. It was anciently named Cluain-Dolcan, and by the Danes Dun-awley. The village consists chiefly of one irregular street, of small but neatly built cottages. The only public buildings are the Parish Church, a small plain modern building, a neat Roman Catholic Church, and a Public Library, erected through the munificence of Andrew Carnegie in 1910, and a Parochial and two National Schools. The ancient round tower is the nearest structure of the kind to the metropolis, and is in a state of good preservation. It stands 100 feet high, 15 feet in diameter, and is covered with a conical roof of stone.
