The Presbyterian Theological Faculty, Ireland, was incorporated by Royal Charter in 1881, and is empowered to grant Degrees in Theology to ministers and licentiates of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland, and to University Graduates who have studied at least One Session in either of the two Theological Colleges belonging to the Presbyterian Church in Ireland. The Presbyterian Theological Faculty has its seat in Belfast, but examinations for the Degree of Bachelor in Divinity are held annually in the Assembly's College, Belfast, and in the Magee College, Londonderry.
