The Presbyterian Theological Faculty, Ireland, was incorporated by Royal Charter in 1831, and is empowered to grant Degrees in Theology to ministers and licentiates of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland, and to University Graduates who have studied at least One Session in the Presbyterian College, Belfast, or the Theological Department of M'Crea Magee College; Londonderry, Ireland. The Presbyterian Theological Faculty has its seat in Belfast, but examinations for the Degree of Bachelor in Divinity are held annually in the Presbyterian College, Belfast, and in the M'Crea Magee College, Londonderry. The Degree of D.D. is conferred Honoris causa.
