

UNITED FREE CHURCH OF SCOTLAND.

By the decision of the General Assembly of the United Free Church of Scotland the Presbytery of Ireland was dissolved on 30th June, 1922. The congregations of Ballyfrenis, Craigmere, Killaig, and Loanends were united with the Irish Presbyterian Church, and the remaining congregations became amalgamated with the United Free Church of Scotland Presbytery of Irvine and Kilmarnock.
