**RANELAGH AND CULLENSWOOD—see RATHMINES AND RATHGAR URBAN DISTRICT.**

**Ranelagh**, a suburban district in the parish of St. Peter, Upperross barony, Dublin county, two miles S.E. from the General Post Office, Dublin, comprising an area of 170 acres. It is situated on the road to Dundrum and Enniskerry. Here is a Carmelite Convent, with a neat Chapel, and a Methodist Church, also the Sandford Church of Ireland, built in 1826. There is a station on the Dublin and South-Eastern Railway here. About half a mile further on is Cullenswood, a village in the same parish and barony as Ranelagh, comprising an area of 118 acres. Electric Trams run to and from Sackville-street every five minutes.
