Is the property of W.H. Ryves Esq. of Ryves Castle. Contains 312 a. 0 r. 29 p. Statute measure. All is arable land, West part of the Townland there is a large wood, one Road bearing direct N. & S. about the centre, East boundary of the wood mentioned is a Road, there are but a few houses in the Townland interspersed. Nothing of antiquity.
