## R. C. Chapel

-- Inhabitants

Situated in the West end of the Townland of Cloon and J.O'D. and about 1 chain E. of the Shannon.

Situated in the N. end of the Townland of Stradbally.

It was built by subscription about 50 years ago, it is about 90 feet long, 20 broad and 10 high, seated near the river Shannon.

## World's end

-- Inhabitants

Small, a small fort.

J.O'D.

Situated in the W. side of Lacka Townland and within 1 chain of the river Shannon.

It has taken its name as worlds end in consequence of the road ending there at the edge of the bog, then but now reclaimed.

## Cloon House

Situated in the W. end of Cloon Townland and about 2 chains East of the road leading from Castle Connell to the Worlds end.

It is in or about 2 story high 30 feet long and 24 broad, and is said to have been built by a man named Burk who has lost his senses and died by stoping a blessed well which had been formerly where Cloon Ho. now stands, it is said that the house is still haunted by some invisible being, the water which had restored the blind to their sight and the lame to walk now burst up in the edge of the river Shannon and that the Shannon water cannot interfere with it, can be taken out of the Shannon water without a mixture.
