

REPRESENTATION IN DAIL EIREANN.

Before the Union Limerick sent two members to the Irish Parliament; this representation was continued in the Imperial Parliament until 1885, when under the Redistribution of Seats Act of that year its representation was reduced to one member.

Under the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, the city was united to the East Division of the County of Limerick and returned four members.

Under the Electoral Act of 1923, the County and City returned seven members.
